Ineke Klinge is a biologist by training and specialised in immunology and subsequently in gender studies. She wrote her PhD *Gender and bones: the production of osteoporosis 1941-1996* in 1998. At Maastricht University she is responsible for teaching and research in gender studies in health and health care at the Faculty of Health Sciences. In 2000-2001 she was charged with the commissioned Gender Impact Assessment of the EU research programme for the life sciences which resulted in the report *Gender in Research. Gender Impact Assessment of the specific programme of the Fifth Framework Programme Quality of Life and Management of Living Resources* (KLINGE & BOSCH, 2001). Ongoing research in the Netherlands addresses the gender dimension of quality of care systems. She currently acts as an advisor concerning gender issues to several Sixth Framework projects . She has taught extensively on gender studies (inter)nationally.
