In 2000-2001 she was charged with the commissioned Gender Impact Assessment of the EU research programme for the life sciences which resulted in the report *Gender in Research. Ongoing research in the Netherlands addresses the gender dimension of quality of care systems. She currently acts as an advisor concerning gender issues to several Sixth Framework projects.
