HARRIET SILIUS

Harriet Silius is Professor of Women's Studies and Director of the Institute of Women's Studies at Åbo Akademi University in Finland. She is member of the board for the Nordic Research School in Interdisciplinary Gender Studies that will start in 2004. She was President of the Association for Feminist Education and Research in Europe 1999 -2003. She has acted in several expert tasks in the framework programmes of the European Commission. She is also replacement member of the board of the Nordic Institute for Gender Research (NIKK) in Oslo. Prof. Silius also serves as peer reviewer for grants of research councils and scientific foundations in Finland, Sweden, Norway, and on the Nordic level. She is member of Editorial Boards for feminist journals and referee for Finnish, Nordic and European feminist journals. Prof. Silius was one of 11 partners in the recently completed research project with EU FP5 funding called *Employment and Women's Studies: The Impact of Women's Studies Training on Women's Employment in Europe*. One of her ongoing research projects is called *Gender equality in the Nordic countries: between rhetoric and practice*. Professor Silius has published widely in the fields of sociology of professions, European welfare state, ethnicity, women's life stories and the institutionalisation of Women's Studies.
